PRACTICAL INFORMATION

TRAVELLING FROM THE CHISINAU AIRPORT TO THE CITY CENTRE

1) Express bus service:

This is the cheapest way to travel to the city centre. The bus fare is 3 MDL (approximately 0.14 EUR). You can buy the tickets directly from the driver. To arrive in the city centre, get off at the Stefan cel Mare Avenue stop.

The express bus service runs daily from 07:00 AM-19:00 PM every 40 mins.

2) Minibus taxi No 165:

An alternative to the express bus service is the minibus taxi. The bus fare is 3 MDL (approximately 0.14 EUR). You can buy the tickets directly from the driver. To arrive in the city centre, get off at the Stefan cel Mare Avenue stop.


The minibus runs daily from 05:30 AM – 21:55 PM every 10 mins.

3) Taxi:

Using a taxi is the most convenient way to travel to the city centre. A taxi ride to the centre costs around 100 MDL (approximately 4.7 EUR).

PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN CHISINAU

There are three types of public transportation systems within the capital city: **buses, trolleybuses, and maxi-taxis.**

There are no predefined schedules for public transportation. Generally, the waiting time is between 3 to 30 minutes depending on the route and the time of day.

If you travel by [trolleybus](#), you should purchase the ticket soon after you get on the trolleybus from the ticket seller. The ticket seller usually walks through the bus so that everyone has a chance to buy a ticket. The cost is only 2 MDL. You must keep the ticket until the end of the journey as random checks are conducted during journeys. Travelling without a ticket will incur a penalty fee.

You can also take a [bus](#) at a cost of 3 MDL. Again, you buy your ticket when you get on the bus.

Important: The ticket you buy in buses or trolleybuses are valid only for that ride, and that particular type of transportation. You cannot buy tickets ahead a time, it will not be valid. Every time you get on the bus, you have to buy the ticket on the spot.
