Ahead of two key European celebrations — **World Inclusion Day** and **Erasmus Days** — the ACT-INCLUSIVE project is mobilising students and educators by providing innovative, free resources designed to make inclusion a reality in every classroom.



The project was created on the recognition that while inclusive education is mandated by the United Nations ([UNCRPD](#)¹ in particular) and the [EU Pillar of Social Rights](#), many schools still lack the resources and training to embrace the diverse support needs of all learners.

The ACT-INCLUSIVE project is actively encouraging schools and communities to engage in activities that promote inclusiveness in schools and use the ACT-INCLUSIVE tools during upcoming events:

- **World Inclusion Day (October 10):** A dedicated moment to celebrate differences and promote universal acceptance, support and embrace everyone's unique qualities. The project's ready-to-use [Toolbox](#), the [Comic Book](#) and the [Audio Book](#) raise awareness on inclusion and education. These can be used for schools planning activities to promote social acceptance and belonging on this day.
- **Erasmus Days (October 13-18):** As a project funded by the Erasmus+ Programme, ACT-INCLUSIVE will join the global celebration of European mobility and cooperation. The project's transnational partnership and the wealth of multilingual materials demonstrate the power of European collaboration in advancing social inclusion.
