## Objectives

- 2 Offer a pilot MOOC focusing on strategies to organise inclusive, welcoming communities that engage effectively with persons with disabilities.
- 3 Building the commitment of local and national authorities to inclusive community-building efforts.
- 4 Building an informal community of practice and multistakeholder collaboration in the field of inclusive communities.
